Issa Nyaphaga is originally from Cameroon in Africa, he lives now in Paris, France. He blends artistic sensibilities from his experiences growing up in his village with modern day materials and his own esthetic to create portraits, paintings, and sculptures using paint, natural and recycled materials. Picture portraits with plastic spoon noses and matchbox mouths. Last time Issa was at our camp we built a HUGE figure out of empty plastic soda pop bottles, she had ears made of old shoes and was about 10 feet tall!

Bryant Holsenbeck is an artist living in Durham who specializes in using the stuff we normally throw away in her art installations. . . richly colored mandalas made of bottle caps, birds made of old wire and thrown out fabric, books made of recycled paper and candy wrappers, a labyrinth made of old shoes. Her work is gorgeous, elegant, and thought provoking.
